10 WHEREAS, this matter came on for consideration by the Court upon  
11 motions of Bernalillo County, Albuquerque Bernalillo County Water Utility  
12 Authority, and New Mexico Affordable Reliance Energy Alliance to intervene for  
13 the purpose of responding to the joint motion for stipulated dismissal, and the  
14 Court having considered the foregoing and being sufficiently advised, Chief  
15 Justice C. Shannon Bacon, Justice Michael E. Vigil, Justice David K. Thomson,

17 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the motions to intervene are  
18 GRANTED;

19 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the joint response from the above  
20 Intervenors filed on March 16, 2023, is ACCEPTED;

21 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any further motions to intervene shall be  
22 filed **on or before April 07, 2023**, and a conditionally filed response to the joint  
23 motion for stipulated dismissal must be filed contemporaneously with any motion
